Dear Senior and Parents,

Wednesday, October 14th is a day designated for seniors to participate in postsecondary opportunities. While sophomores and juniors are testing on this day, seniors will be afforded the opportunity to gain information regarding their postsecondary aspirations.

For this to be a success it must be a joint effort of parents, students, and the school. Since students will not report to school for this activity, we (the school) must know that you (the parents) know where they are and what they are doing.

The following postsecondary activities are approved:

- **Job Shadow** –Arrangements must be made in advance to go to work with someone in a career of interest. The day may be split between two occupations.
- **Postsecondary Visits** - Arrangements must be made in advance to visit, virtually or on-site, places that the student is considering attending for post-secondary training, certifications, or degrees. This includes any location where the student would be able to receive valuable information and guidance concerning their post-secondary aspirations, such as visiting businesses to learn about potential apprenticeships, traveling to a base or recruiting center to learn about enlisting in the military, traveling to a college campus to learn more about degree programs and scholarship opportunities, etc. Parents are encouraged to participate in these activities with their students. Students and their parents who wish to visit a location in person are reminded that they must make an appointment in advance, so that the facility they will be visiting is prepared to provide information and answer your questions. Please call as soon as possible to make those arrangements. Use the institution’s website to locate contact information and schedule an appointment. Students and parents may also explore post-secondary opportunities virtually, visiting websites and learning more about the career and college options they are considering.
- **Other Educational Activities** - Seniors may also use this day to complete other post-secondary activities, such as writing college essays, working on and completing college applications, and applying for scholarships.

By completing and submitting this form by October 8, you are committing your student to participate in a postsecondary opportunity. Your student will be coded as CV (College/Career Visit) for the day. October 14th is not considered as one of the three postsecondary visit days allowed for seniors. Students who do not participate will be coded PX for the day.
