

Create a Parent Account




As a partner in your child's education, follow these steps to create a parent account and review your child's career planning activities.

Step 1: Visit [Indiana Career Explorer](#)

Step 2: Select *Create an Account* at the top of the screen

Step 3: Select *I am a parent of a junior high or high school student*.

Step 4: Complete all 4 steps to create YOUR PARENT account. **Note:** You will need to have your student *generate a parent account code* to link the student and parent accounts. Parents with existing user accounts will simply need their student to log in and send the access code. Parents will then log in to their account and input the access code to connect the student's account to their account.
